Our opening bank account total was £84,526 and the closing figure was £106,768

The accounts for 2022 were prepared and agreed and signed off by an independent examiner which is a requirement of the Charity Commission when the income of the charity exceeds £25,000.

Applications for new grants carried on throughout 2022 and into 2023, and it's true to say that our financial position regarding funds for the new village hall is now significantly improved on that at the end of the 2022 reporting year. In 2023 we have received CIL funding as well a UK Prosperity Grant totalling £205,000. In all we have around £350,000 now available for the new village hall.
